A special award was established in 1998 to honor the memory of **Rell Kapolioka'ehukai Sunn**, the "*First Lady of Surfing*." Rell was diagnosed with breast cancer when she was just 32 and given only months to live. Rather than submitting to the disease and giving up on life, Rell did exactly the opposite. Fifteen years after her diagnosis, Rell Sunn passed away at the age of 47, leaving a legacy of someone who always lived life to its fullest.

This perpetual trophy is awarded each year to the person or persons who best embody the true aloha spirit and display the qualities shared by Rell and the Luau & Longboard Invitational - the battle against cancer, combined with unselfishness, compassion and a dedication to helping others.
